Downtown Flowers

On Thursday, June 18, Parks & Recreation staff directed Monroe Correctional Complex inmates in planting approximately 2,000 flowers in the end caps of the landscaped islands along Main Street and Lewis Street. Flowers have been grown from seed each year for the past 6 years at the prison complex, at a savings of approximately \$900 annually to our community. This is a great example of a government agency partnership working together for the greater benefit of the community that we serve.

New Free Life Jacket Loaner Program @ Lake Tye Park

The City's contracted concessionaire has agreed to provide free life jacket loaners at the Lake Tye Park concession stand when they are open for this summer season. The free life jacket loaner program is run by Safe Kids of Snohomish County, a non-profit organization, who has partnered with the Snohomish County Parks Department, Monroe Fire District 3 and now the City of Monroe Parks & Recreation Department.

New Kayak Rentals @ Lake Tye Park

On Tuesday, June 23 the Monroe City Council authorized the Mayor to sign an addendum to the concessionaire agreement to offer kayak rentals at the Lake Tye Park concession stand for the 2015 summer season. The concessionaire expects to start the rental program on or about July 1.

Athletic Courts Resurfacing Project

The City of Monroe has awarded a contract to Combined Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$34,848.00 to resurface the tennis and basketball courts at Lake Tye Park and Wales Street Park. The project is a budgeted Parks Capital Improvement Project and the work is expected to be completed by the end of this summer.

NSA Western World Series

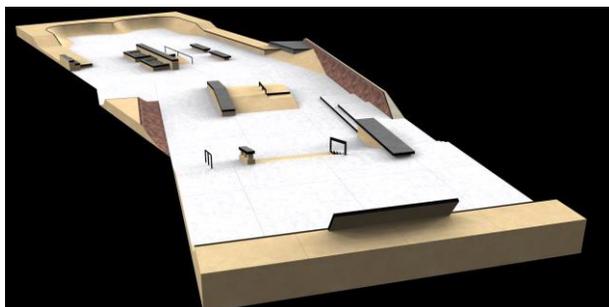

July is Parks & Recreation Month

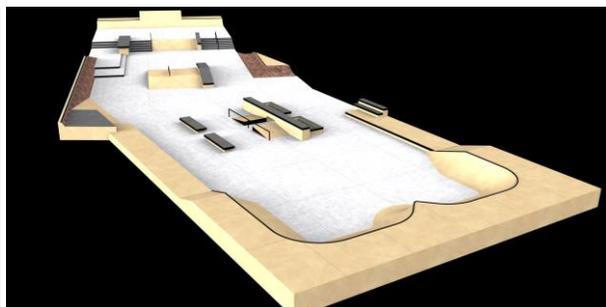
