



DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: Sunnyside Gardens Townhomes

Description of Proposal: The project consists of a mixed-use development with 11 multi-family buildings for a total of 46 townhome units and 1 commercial building on two parcels approximately 1.87 acres. The entrance will be off of West Main Street with an internal fire apparatus road that will provide access to each unit.
