NOTICE is hereby given that a **PUBLIC HEARING** has been scheduled for **Tuesday, January 11, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.** for the **MONROE WOODLANDS ANNEXATION (AN2020-01)** by the Monroe City Council. The City Council meeting will be held virtually via the Zoom Meeting platform. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The proposed annexation area is contiguous with existing City limits, lies in unincorporated Snohomish County, is contained within the City's UGA, and may generally be described as an area of approximately 178.19 acres located in the Monroe Woodlands area west of 175th Ave SE and includes future US 2 bypass right-of-way. The proposed annexation area is contiguous with the Foothills neighborhood located immediately to the south. Immediately to the east is the Robinhood neighborhood. The annexation Notice of Intent was circulated per the petition method.
